- Knowledge of national and international laws and policies relating to Right to Food, Food Sovereignty, Livelihood and Natural Resources and Agricultural Development Policy and Strategy
- Excellent skills in written and spoken English and Nepali including the ability and experience to compose, edit, analyse and report using complex information
- Excellent interpersonal, networking, communication, negotiation and facilitation skills
- Excellent computer skills including navigating email, internet and MS WORD, Excel, and PowerPoint
