## **ROLE PURPOSE:**

Save the Children is the leading independent organization for children. We save children's lives; we fight for their rights; we help them fulfil their potential. The Project Coordinator - Education (REFAT) will be responsible for overall management of the education in emergencies response to the 2017 floods in, Saptari and Sarlahi. S/he will also provide technical assistance to partner NGOs and GOs, ensuring the high quality of implementation by maximizing the impact as per the country strategy and annual plans.

- Prepare quality reports as per the requirements. Document and disseminate lesson learnt, case study and innovative approach at district and regional levels.
- Provide technical supervision for the utilization of training through coaching, feedback and suggestion to maximize the impact.

- Represent SC within regional, national and international forum as per need.
- Work as a resource person with different external visitors.
- Participate in strategic planning process.
- Work as team member in an emergency situation.
